



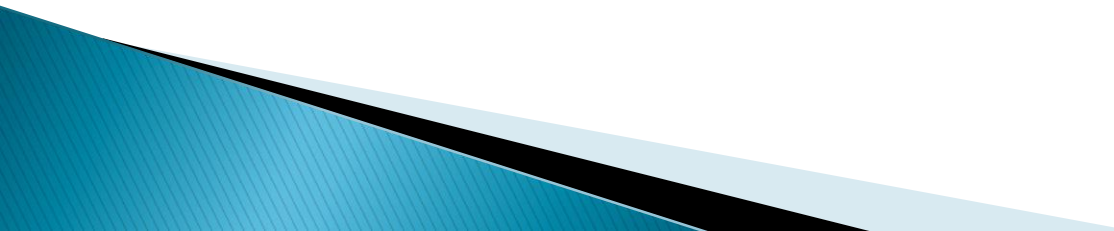

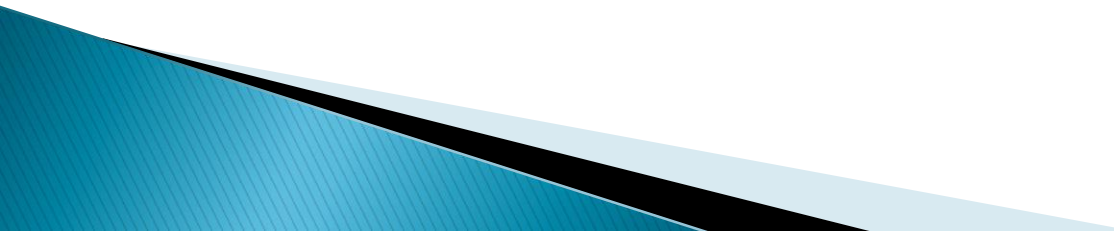
New National Curriculum 2014

- ▶ Parents are our most important partners in teaching Abingdon children

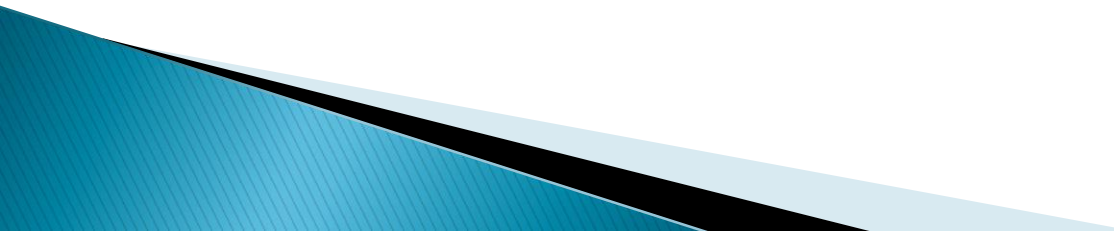
Why do I need to help school?

- ▶ Parents can improve children's overall learning by at least 30%
 - ▶ Children who are listened to, when reading, by parents can improve by 20%
 - ▶ Children who are taught to read by parents can improve by 110%
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New National Curriculum 2014

- ▶ Old National Curriculum
 - ▶ National Curriculum -designed by Abingdon Teachers
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Old levels

- ▶ Start at L1
 - ▶ Go up to L6 in primary
 - ▶ Have sub-levels 1 a, 1 b, 1 c –where c is lower than a
 - ▶ Key points for assessment are Year 2 and Year 6
 - ▶ In Year 2 a child was expected to be Level 2
 - ▶ In Year 6 a child was expected to be Level 4
