As a year group we will be discussing what it means to be resilient.


### Commitment:

We will be listening to the stories of real-life Superheroes such as Florence Nightingale, Rosa Parks and David Livingstone and discovering what they did to make the world a better place.

### As Artists:

We will be designing and creating a superhero outfit to help our superheroes to carry out their missions.

### As Scientists:

We will be exploring our senses and using them to investigate everyday materials. We will also be experimenting with our own superhero powers- have you got a super memory, super hearing, super singing voice or are you super stretchy?
