Commitment:

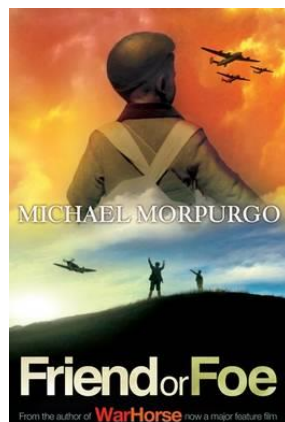
Children will take greater ownership of their topic based learning by presenting findings in their own creative books.

Home Learning

Each week, pupils must ensure that they read on a daily basis and complete their reading records. They should also learn their times tables off by heart to 12x12, including decimals. For example, $6 \times 0.6 = 3.6$. Children will be tested weekly on spellings.

As Geographers:

Linking with our topic, the children will compare and contrast urban and rural locations. This will be kick-started with a trip to Danby on September 6th!

As Artists:

The pupils will use their Creative Books to collect and record visual information from different sources as well as planning and trying out new ideas.

As Scientists:

As part of our science week, children will learn about Evolution and Inheritance.
