Parent Information Sheet

Year 3 "Through The Ages."

We will journey back in time to the time of the Stone Age. As we travel into the past we will learn about what life was like for our pre-historic ancestors, from hunting and cave painting to clothing and homes. We will follow our ancestors into the Bronze Age and travel with them to the Iron Age.

Aspiration:

Children will discuss goals and aspirations and display these in handmade time capsules.

Commitment:

We will be using art and DT to explore a class text in literacy lessons. The artwork produced will also inspire creative writing.

Harmony:

Children will work in pairs and groups to explore the varying emotions of a character in a story. They will have the opportunity to use this in creative writing and evaluate and improve writing with peers.

Topic Challenge Home Learning

Research Skara Brae to discover and understand what it is and who may have lived there. Build a replica of Skara Brae using junk material at home.

To create a cave painting to tell a story of an aspect of life in the Stone Age e.g. hunting, gathering.

As Historians:

We will learn about what life was like for people in the past. Using our imagination to think about what the world was like. Imagining what we would have seen, heard smelt, tasted as Stone Aged people.

As Artists:

Children will use a wide range of art and construction materials to create artwork linked to the Stone Age.

As Scientists:

We will take part in an archaeological dig to unearth the remains of ancient objects. Our science topic will be about the life cycle of a plant and the impact this has on our lives.
