Year 4 - The Last Viking

Come with us on a journey through history! Visit an era of trading, raiding and blood-thirsty battles!

This half-term we will be learning about the Anglo-Saxon people, their way of life and their religion and customs, and their demise following the invasion of the Vikings.

Aspiration:

Year 4 are aspiring to become museum curators. This half term children will have the opportunity to research and write reports about Anglo-Saxon life, and create a museum experience in our classroom.

Commitment:

This half term year 4 will be committed to learning and practising all times tables ready for the national test in April.

Resilience:

Children will be resilient in creating a maze game in ICT which will be used in the classroom museum.

Home Learning

As reading is incredibly important, we ask that you read with your child for 15 minutes every night and sign the home reading records. Children should also be practising weekly spelling lists and need to know all of their times tables by the end of year 4.

As Historians:

We will be creating a class museum using real Anglo-Saxon artefacts and learning about a local Saxon princess. We will also create timelines of this era.

As Artists:

This half term children will design and make Anglo-Saxon artefacts to display in our 'Museum in a Classroom'.

As Scientists:

Children will learn about the basic parts of the digestion system, types of teeth and their functions .

PE will be on a Thursday this half term. We often have extra PE sessions throughout the week, so PE kits need to be in school for the entire half term.
