Children will take ownership of their topic and trying hard to improve their reading, writing and counting.

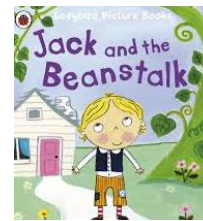
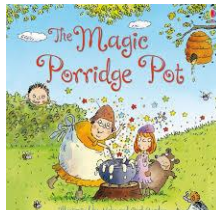
Harmony:
