Commitment:

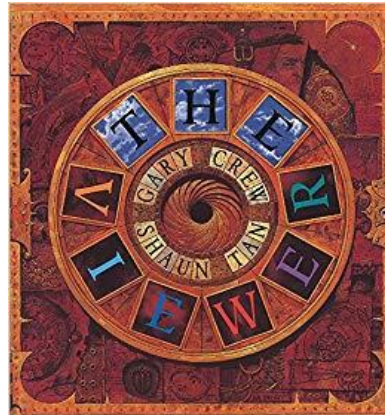
Children will take greater ownership of their learning by developing a clear understanding of their personalised targets in each curriculum area.

Home Learning

Each week, pupils must ensure that they read on a daily basis and complete their reading records. They should also learn their times tables off by heart to 12x12, including decimals. For example, $6 \times 0.6 = 3.6$. Children will be tested weekly on spellings.

As Historians:

Year 6 pupils will look at the chronology of major historical events, in particular those shown in The Viewer.

As Artists:

In our Creative Books, the children will design their own Viewer. This will include creating a pictorial timeline of their lives in the style of the illustrator.

As Scientists:

As part of science week, children will learn about animal classification: mammals, birds, fish, amphibians and reptiles!
