Spell:

homophones (e.g. their / there)

Use adjectives, conjunctions and correct sentence punctuation.  
Use past and present tense verbs correctly.  
Use question marks and exclamation marks correctly.

Write at length a range of different types of writing.

Plan what they want to write before writing.  
Reread their writing to check it makes sense.  
Proof read their writing for spelling and grammar errors.
