Commitment:

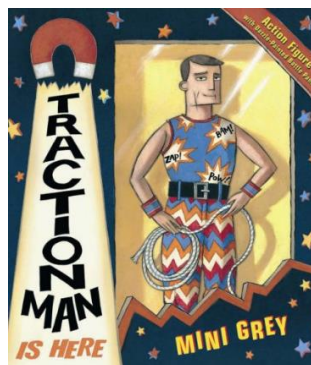
We will commit to working hard to improving our reading and writing.
