Commitment:

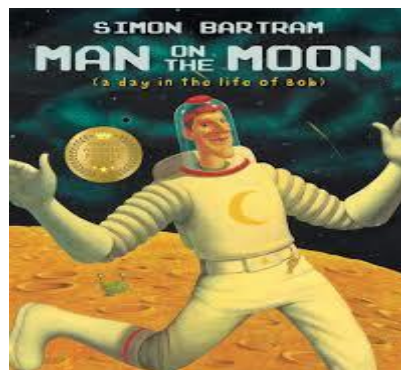
We will be talking about our commitment to coming in to school ready to learn and bringing our book bag each day.
