Term Dates:

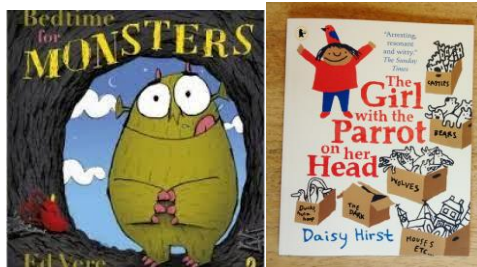
Monday 14th June to Wednesday 21st July
