Topic Challenge Home Learning

As Geographers:

Children will be using a range of maps, online satellite mapping and atlases to locate the oceans and continents of the world, as well as locating Middlesbrough's influences globally.

As Artists:

We will be developing our knowledge of colour mixing, look at artists who have been inspired by water and the sea, and then create our own

As Scientists:

We will take a close look at natural metals and the process to create man-made metals. We will consider their uses and investigate the properties.
