Creativity:

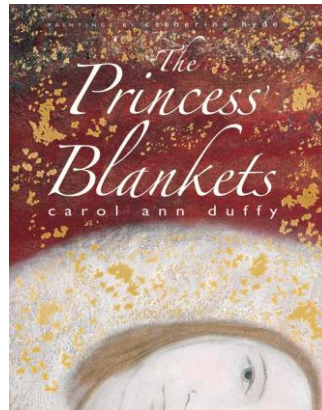
Children will take greater ownership of their topic-based learning by presenting findings in a variety of ways.

Home Learning
