Children will be developing their memory skills by thinking back to previous learning and memories, even when it can be tricky!

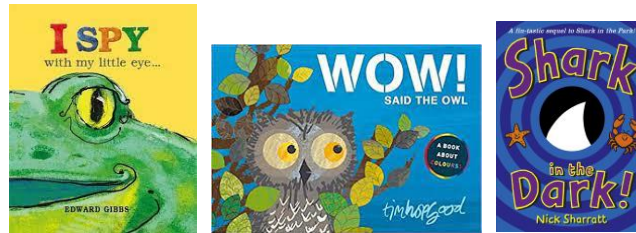
#### **Commitment:**

#### **Topic Challenge Home Learning**

This half term is all about colours, as we learn more about nature and the bold and colourful festivals celebrated around the world including Diwali, Bonfire Night and Christmas. You can help your child's learning at home by talking about celebrations that you enjoy sharing with your family and friends.

You could:

- Play a family game of colour I spy, "I spy with my little eye, something the colour of... blue/red/pink".
- Ask your child to help with jobs such as sorting out the washing into piles sorted by colour.
- Go on a rainbow treasure hunt, can you find things around your home for each colour of the rainbow?  
Can you make them into a rainbow picture?
- Look out of the window morning and night, what is the same and what is different? What animals can you see?

#### **As Authors:**

We will be reading and joining in with the stories of 'I Spy With My Little Eye', 'Wow Said the Owl' and 'Shark in the Dark' along with many others!

#### **As Explorers:**

We will be learning more about the world around us and the animals we share it with! We will also be learning about day and night.

#### **As Creators:**

We will learn more about colours and colour mixing. We will be using lots of different tools to make marks!
