Year 3 The Stone Age

We will journey back in time to the time of the Stone Age. As we travel into the past we will learn about what life was like for our pre-historic ancestors, from hunting and cave painting to clothing and homes. We will follow our ancestors into the Bronze Age and travel with them to the Iron Age.

Aspiration:

Children will discuss goals and aspirations in class and work towards them throughout the term.

Commitment and Resilience:

Children will be encouraged to show commitment and resilience when working in order to develop a 'can do' attitude and to help them continue with their progress.

Harmony:

Children will work in pairs and groups to explore the varying emotions of a character in a story. They will have the opportunity to use this in creative writing and evaluate and improve writing with peers.

Topic Challenge Home Learning

Research Skara Brae to discover and understand what it is and who may have lived there. Build a replica of Skara Brae using junk material at home.

To create a cave painting to tell a story of an aspect of life in the Stone Age e.g. hunting, gathering.

As Historians:

We will learn about what life was like for people in the past. Using our imagination to think about what the world was like. Imagining what we would have seen, heard smelt, tasted as Stone Aged people.

As Artists:

This term, we will be exploring printmaking. We will be making mono-prints and exploring relief printing.

As Scientists:

We will compare, group and name different rocks. We will find out about fossils and well as different soil formations.
