Commitment:

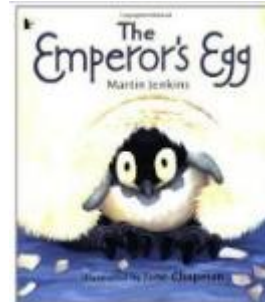
We will commit to reading at home every night and learning our spellings.

As Geographers:

We will find out about hot and cold places in the world. We will look at the Antarctic and learn about compass directions. We will learn about the seasons in the UK.

As scientists:

We will be learning about the structures and body parts of different animals. We will find out about the various diets and habitats of animals and we will write 'Riddle Me This' puzzles.
