Year 6 - World War 2

This half term Y6 will be reading 'Friend or Foe' by Michael Morpurgo. This story is set in WW2 and follows the lives of two young boys who are evacuated to the countryside. Children will learn what it would have been like to live in the 1940s when the country was at war!

Aspiration:

To continue to have high aspirations and continue to work hard in all lessons.

Resilience:

The challenges that the children are set will prepare them for the next stage in their education.

Creativity:

Children will take greater ownership of their topic-based learning by presenting findings in a variety of ways.

Harmony:

Children will cooperate whilst developing empathy for evacuees.

Home Learning

Each week, pupils must ensure that they read on a daily basis and complete their Class DoJo tasks. They should also learn their times tables off by heart to 12x12, including decimals. For example, $6 \times 0.6 = 3.6$. Children will be tested weekly on spellings.

As Geographers:

Linking with our topic, the children will compare and contrast urban and rural locations. We will be identifying different countries that were impacted by WW2 and plot where people were evacuated to.

As Artists:

The pupils will make models of an Anderson Shelter.

As History:

The children will learn how World War 2 affected the lives of normal citizens in Britain. They will also learn about key events of the time period.

Useful Information:

PE will be once a week. We may have extra PE sessions in the week, so we ask that PE kits are brought into school during the first week of term and left here until the end of term.
