We will continue to practise digital resilience and show resilience in all areas of school life.

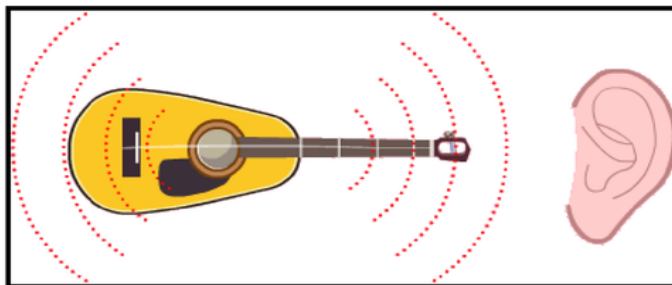
Commitment
