We will continue to settle into Nursery and follow the routine.

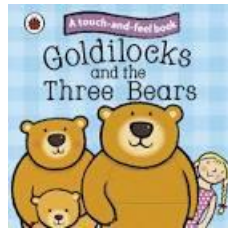
Commitment:
