The children will stay committed to their home learning and take ownership of what times tables they need to practise.

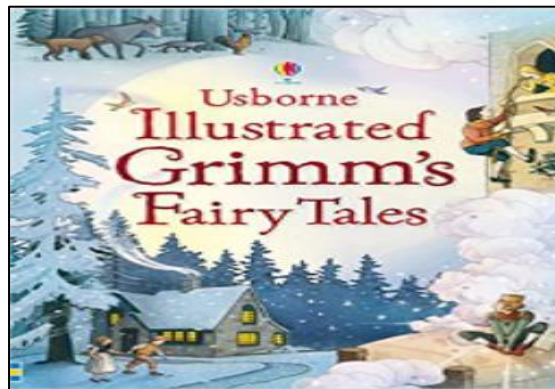
## **Harmony:**
